Luke was a competitive league bowler and tournament bowler around the Mid North Coast. Luke also represented Port Macquarie in the far northern zone country challenge for many years making numerous state finals.

Luke was a great team mate and also a great opponent this was made evident by Luke's numerous best sportsman's awards, the far northern country challenge sportsman's award is subsequently now named the Luke Fowler sportsman's award.

Luke lost his battle with cancer late in 2011 though his memory is still very strong with those he left behind.
